

BINIBECA DIVING PROTOCOL 2021 AGAINST COVID-19

This security protocol will be applied in response to the current pandemic caused by the SARS-COV2 virus and will be updated to respond to the health situation in which we find ourselves at each moment of the season.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE POSSIBLE RISKS OF CONTAGIOUS CLIENTS

in the diving center facilities, we detected as the main possible risk of contagion contact with other diving clients, with the common areas of the facilities and with the material that is rented

It is for this reason that we decided to implement the protocols subscribed in this document.

AREAS MORE SUSCEPTIBLE TO POSSIBLE CONTAGION

In general, the areas that we identify with a higher risk of contagion are:

- Office
- Classroom
- Changing rooms and bathroom
- Transfer vehicle
- Boat

WHAT INDIVIDUAL PROTECTION MEASURES WILL WE APPLY?

It will be mandatory for all dive center clients to wear a personal mask from arrival at the dive center until the moment they enter the water and from the moment they finish the dive until they leave the diving center premises.

When accessing the different areas of the dive center, the client will find disinfectant liquid in each of them and it will be the obligation of all clients to use this liquid that the dive center will make available to them.

The diving equipment for rent will be perfectly disinfected and sanitized with a product that meets all the recommended standards. Anyway, from the direction of the diving center we recommend that all divers have the following elements of their own:

- Mask
- Snorkel
- Scuba regulator

If they are not available, they can be purchased or rented at our facilities.

Dive center staff will wear a mask at all times, as currently required.

In the common areas of our facilities, the recommended social distancing rules must be complied with and the maximum capacity indicated at the entrance of each premises must be respected.

To minimize the entry of divers at the reception, an online form will be sent at the time of booking that the diver can fill out. In this way we reduce the time of each client at the reception and avoid the use of paper, which is very important to us. Likewise, the payment can be made electronically before the start of the activity.

In the transport vehicle, the use of a personal mask is also mandatory. We recommend that clients arrive at the dive center using their own vehicle.

The facilities, as well as the vehicle and the boat will be disinfected with OX-VIRIN, a bactericidal / fungicidal / viricidal product collected within those recommended by the Ministry of Health for the correct disinfection of surfaces and which is also 100% biodegradable.

Inside the boat, all clients and staff of the center must wear the mask at all times. Upon arrival at the dive point and after equipping, each client will leave their mask in front of their seat and will put the diving mask and regulator in their mouth to enter the water.

In case of emergency situations under water that require the assistance of a dive buddy, the regulator for this purpose will be provided, identified by the yellow hose. Both the main regulator and the emergency regulator must always be kept in disinfection conditions, even if it is material owned by the diver.

To defog the masks, both rental and personal, the dive center will provide anti-fog sprays available to customers.

DISINFECTION OF RENTAL EQUIPMENT

- The rental equipment will be delivered in a perfect state of disinfection and delivered by a single member of the dive center.
- Once returned, the dive center staff will be in charge of the correct disinfection following the protocols:
 1. Sweetening the diving equipment with hose
 2. The diving equipment will be immersed in a liquid solution with an appropriate disinfectant for the time of 15 minutes indicated by the manufacturer.
 3. We have two types of disinfectants, one for the parts of the equipment in contact with the face-mouth of the divers and another for the rest of the equipment. Both from the well-known dive brand, Cressi Sub.
 4. Scuba gear will be sun dried and deemed available for the next customer's use.
 5. Special care will be taken with BCD masks, snorkels and regulators..
- In the case of compressed air cylinders, will be disinfected after each use and the standard recommendations of the Ministry of Industry will be followed for the air filling.

From the direction of the diving center we reserve the right to update these protocols according to the health situation of each moment.
